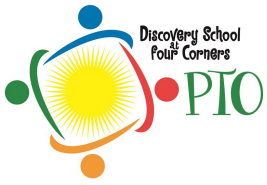
## **General Meeting 3:15PM - 4:15PM:**

### III. Business in Progress

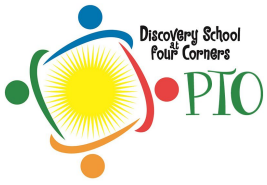
- Send how to get in touch with the PTO home in folders?
